- It was written in response to ELO delegate feedback, requesting a staff development programme which specifically addresses how to tackle students who are more difficult to engage.
- The aim is to move the focus from 'teaching' to 'learning' by supporting young people to develop better learning behaviours.
- No matter where we are in our career, there will be classes and individuals who pose a challenge... this programme aims to provide a toolkit of approaches to be tried and tested!



## ELB Programme Content:

### Session 1 | Knowing Me, Knowing You...

- To reflect on your current practice.
- To identify strengths and areas for development in current practice.
- To identify strengths and areas for development for key individuals or classes.

### Session 2 | The Butterfly Effect

- To use marginal gains theory in order to identify small steps which lead to lasting change.
- To explore behaviour scenarios and identify behaviour traits.
- To identify strategies to reduce the impact of negative behaviours.
- To explore how a "growth mindset" is important in the classroom.

### Session 3 | Over To Them...

- To consider strategies which promote effective learning disposition in students.
