## **Election of Parent Governor**

There is a vacancy for a parent to serve on the Local Governing Committee of Sacred Heart Catholic High School. Parent governors are important members of this committee. They share equally with other governors the wide range of responsibilities for carrying out the work of the Local Governing Committee and for contributing to reports and information submitted to the Board of Bishop Bewick Catholic Education Trust. All parents who currently have a child attending Sacred Heart Catholic High School are eligible to nominate themselves for election as Parent Governor. All Governors complete a skills audit in order to ensure there is a breadth of knowledge, skills and experience amongst the members of the Committee.

The term of office for a Parent Governor is 4 years.

The Governing Committee meets four times in the academic year. In addition, the work of the Committee is completed through Key Lines of Enquiry agreed by the Committee and carried out by an individual or groups of Governors.

If you wish to nominate yourself as Parent Governor a nomination form can be obtained from the school office. This should be returned by 8.30am on Monday the 6<sup>th</sup> of October 2025. If more than 1 person nominates themselves for the position of Parent Governor, then an election will be held and you will be asked to submit information as to why you wish to be elected as a Parent Governor. All parents with a student attending the school at the time are eligible to nominate themselves and to vote in this election.
